

Nottely Boat Club & Marina

Reservation Policy

In order to ensure a safe and enjoyable lake experience, we would appreciate your honoring the terms and conditions of our policies.

Rentals:

Renters must be 21 years old and possess a valid Driver's License. A valid major credit card, in the Renter's name, must be used for the damage deposit and will be charged should there be any additional fees or damage to the watercraft. If paying cash, the credit card will be imprinted until full cash payment is made and vessel inspected. We do not accept personal checks.

Should you return the watercraft after your reserved rental time, there will be an additional hourly charge of \$100.00. If you have rented multiple watercraft, the rate per hour will apply to each one rented.

Safety equipment will be provided and inspected upon return. Should any equipment be damaged or missing, your credit card will be charged for the replacement or repair of the equipment, either of which will be done at our discretion.

In order to meet our rental requirements for training and education and to complete paperwork, we ask that you arrive 30 minutes prior to your scheduled rental time.

Reservations:

We suggest that you reserve your watercraft at least 72 hours in advance to ensure that you are able to enjoy your lake experience on the watercraft of your choice.

In order to reserve your watercraft, we require a valid major credit card in the name of the Renter.

There will be no compensation or rate adjustments for late arrivals or early check out. Nottely Boat Club & Marina shall not be held liable for any inconveniences of time lost caused by accident, breakdown, or malfunction of vessel, inclement weather, illness, or change of plans.

Down Payment and Damage Deposit Requirements:

A valid major credit card must be used to hold your watercraft. At the time of booking, 50% of the rental amount is due to hold your reservation. The balance due will be charged to your credit card 7 days prior to your rental date. A \$500 refundable Security Deposit will be pre-authorized on your credit card when you check-in for your reservation time. (The Security Deposit for Non-Motorized Watercraft and Tubes is \$100 per rental.)

Cancellations:

(REGULAR SEASON)

We require a 48 hour notification of cancellation, for a full refund.

Cancellation within 24 hours of your reserved time during our “regular” season will result in a processing fee charged to your credit card, equal to a 2 hours rental of the craft you reserved.

Failure to notify us of your desire to cancel your reservation will result in a charge to your credit card for the full amount of the rental.

(HOLIDAY / PEAK SEASON)

During a holiday weekend or (peak time) which includes several days surrounding the actual holiday date, cancellations are not accepted (NO EXCEPTIONS).

This is due to the rental business and limited number of watercraft available in the area, we have no other choice but to charge full reservation rate for last minute cancellations or no shows.

Rental Rules:

Do not run vessel aground, for any reason.

Renters will incur a \$150 prop replacement fee for damaged propellers.

Absolutely NO PETS are allowed on board our vessels, with the exception of certified service animals. Proof of certification is required. Any evidence of pets on board (hair, nail marks on vinyl or floors, etc.) will result in a minimum charge of \$100 to the damage deposit.

While normal dirtiness is expected, excessive dirt, mud, etc. left in/on the vessel will result in an additional cleaning fee of \$75 charged against the damage deposit, at our discretion.

NO TOWING is allowed on the Sweetwater Cruiser Pontoon.

Be courteous and return the vessel on time and in the same good condition you received it.

Vessels are released with a full tank of gas and must be returned with a full tank. For your convenience, we offer non-ethanol gas at our boat dock, which may be purchased on your return.

Vessels may not be occupied by more than the posted USCG rated person/weight capacity.

Renter agrees to report immediately to management any equipment lost, stolen, broken, or damaged, and may be charged for same.

Renters must follow all laws and regulations regarding vessel operation. Drivers may not operate the vessels in an abusive, reckless, or otherwise negligent manner, or while under the influence of alcohol, or illegal substances.

All guests aboard rented vessels must abide by safety laws. Renter is responsible for any damages and/or losses caused by their guests.

Renters and their guests use Marina property and vessels at their own risk. The Marina is not responsible for any injuries or damages resulting from said use.

Nottely Boat Club & Marina only rents vessels to responsible adults, at least 21 years of age. We reserve the right to deny rental access to any person(s), who in the opinion of Marina personnel might create an unsafe boating situation, or where past experience warrants such refusal. Nottely Boat Club & Marina reserves the right to repossess vessels from Renters if an unsafe situation occurs.

Renter shall have no claim upon Nottely Boat Club & Marina as a result of any grounding, breakdown, or failure of the vessel, or failure of its engine or its equipment, and when such incident is caused by the negligence of the Renter, Nottely Boat Club & Marina shall have the right for a claim.
